A Permanent Home For Rock Point

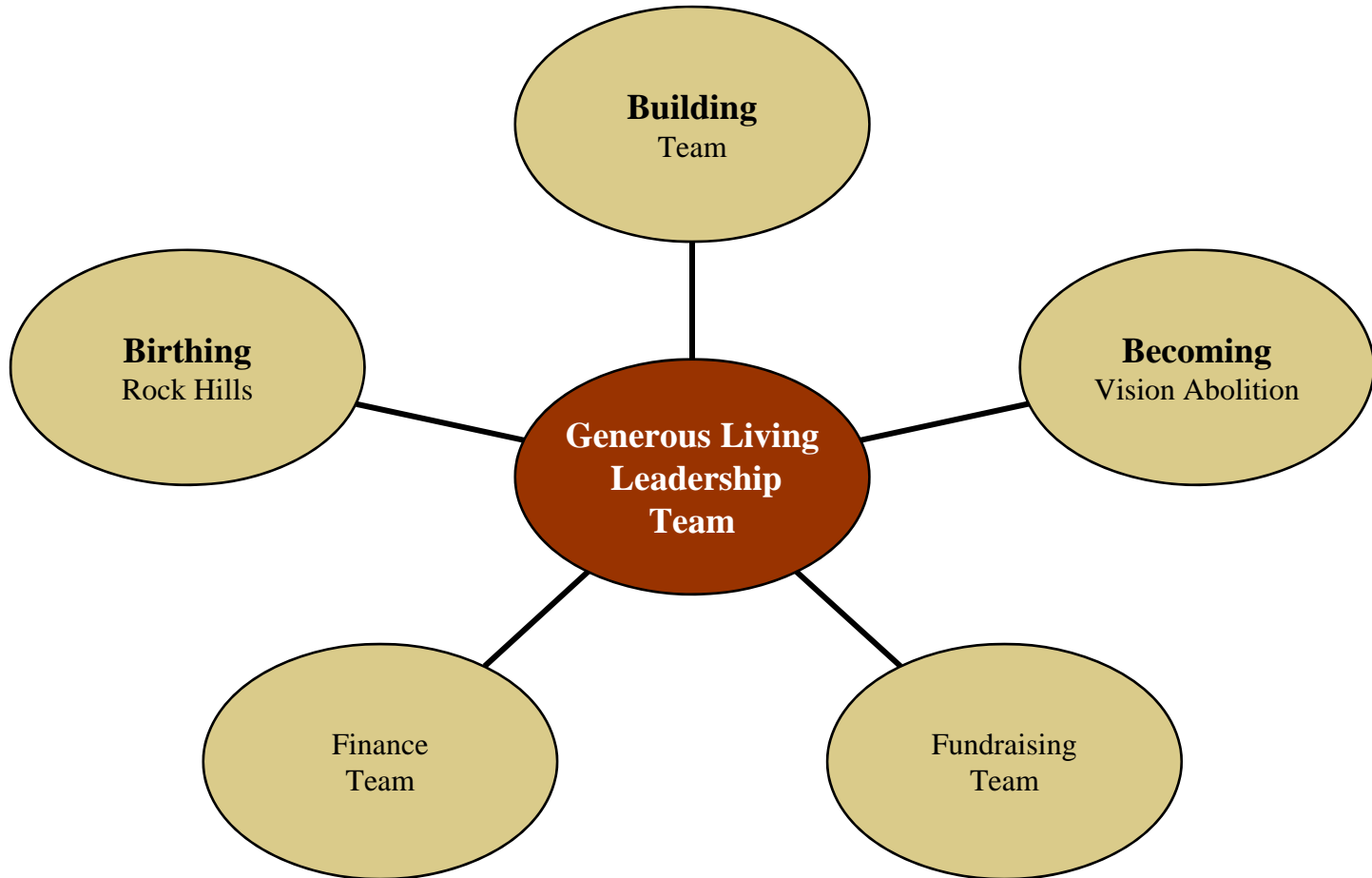
- Will provide more resources to invest in kingdom work over the long-term
