CORE TRUTH:

As a follower of Jesus, you are transformed into a NEW person by the POWER of the Holy Spirit!

Jesus promised Him... *John 14:15-17; 16:7, 13-15*, and He came... *Acts 1:8; 2:1-4*.

Romans 8:1-28

By the POWER of the Holy Spirit, YOU are...

Secure! (vs. 1) (Justification) *Ephesians 1:13-14, 1 John 4:2-6*

Free from the power of sin! (vs. 2-4) *Galatians 4:1-7, Philippians 2:7*

Set apart! (vs. 5-8) Flesh vs. Holy Spirit (Sanctification)
Galatians 5:16-26, 6:8; Ephesians 5:18, Colossians 3:1-17, 1 John 2:27

He is always there; indwells us; partners with us; seals us; consecrates us; talks to us; shows us what we need to change; empowers us; gives us abilities to do things we need to do; regenerates us; leads us; guides us; shows us TRUTH; teaches us; counsels us; helps us; fills us; controls us; corrects us; convicts us; quickens us; changes us and gives us gifts to help each other and put the Body of Christ together!

Made right with God in Christ! (vs. 9-11) (Trinity)

Given the very LIFE of God! (vs. 11-13)

Chosen as His child! (vs. 14-17) *Mark 14:36 "Abba, Father"*

(Glorification) *2 Corinthians 4:17, Genesis 3:16, Matthew 19:28-29*

Strengthened in your weaknesses! (vs. 26-28)
Ephesians 3:16-17,20, 6:18

ENTRY POINT: We are born into a sinful world. We are justified (secured) by Christ's death for our sins. We are sanctified (set apart) when we claim our inheritance as His chosen (salvation). Sanctification is progressive. It involves growth. The power to grow comes from the Holy Spirit, which we have received. **Read I John 2:27.**

"The most effective means the enemy has to keep us from being full of the Spirit, is to keep us full of ourselves." - Beth Moore, from *Praying God's Word*. What demons do you continue to try to fight with your own power when God's call is *surrender to win*?

How do you know that the Holy Spirit is working within you?

In what areas have you been convicted by the Holy Spirit, and what changes (or action) has that conviction required of you?

What do you do to nurture – stay open to - the Spirit of Truth? What does it mean to you to "abide" in the Spirit?
