SHARPEN THE POINT

For further study of today’s message

ENTRY POINT: Paul wanted to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ in Rome but faced many trials along the way. He was shipwrecked and found himself in chains to name a few. This story, much like the deliverance of God’s covenant people from Egypt, is an account of God’s faithfulness in times of opposition, persecution and obstacles. Begin your study by reading Exodus 13:17-22 and Psalm 139:1-12.

Through what storms – or wilderness – have you experienced God’s protection? What lessons did you learn?

What means do you use to chart your daily course? How do you respond when storms blow you off course, or when you are lost in the wilderness?

What things keep you from responding in obedience when you hear God’s direction?

God doesn’t promise comfort or security, but He does promise His presence, guidance and unfailing love. If faith is our foundation, if hope is our focus, then love is our action. How will you love God today? Are you willing to take a stake in the Power of ONE?
